Every two seconds, someone in the United States needs blood. A single donation can save up to three lives — and it only takes about an hour of your time. Supplies are especially critical heading into the summer months, when donation rates typically drop but demand stays high. If you gave blood at the May drive, you ARE eligible to donate again in July.
