# Today! Congregational Meeting and Welcome Statement Vote

With the blessing and authority of the church council, a congregational meeting will take place following worship today. The single item on the agenda for this meeting will be the proposed congregational welcome statement, the adoption of which would designate Diamond Lake Lutheran as a Reconciling in Christ congregation. The Reconciling in Christ team has set the threshold for adopting this statement at 80%, meaning that 80% of those voting at the congregational meeting will need to vote in the affirmative in order for the motion to pass, and the welcome statement to be adopted.

If adopted, this welcome statement will not replace any previous mission or vision statements, but rather will function as a stand-alone statement that communicates far more than a simple "All Are Welcome" stance. It will be featured in our congregational publications and displayed in the Commons of the church building.

Members and friends and other visitors are welcome to stay for the meeting. Only officially recorded members of the congregation (including those received into membership during worship this morning) will be eligible to vote. The vote will be taken by written ballot during the meeting, which will be held in the Sanctuary. We will then convene in the Lakeview Room for the fellowship hour and to hear the result of the vote.


