Our high schoolers are leading worship as they share reflections from their summer service-learning trip to Winston-Salem, North Carolina, through the organization Spark'Dwell.

Spark'Dwell is a partnership between SPARK and The Dwelling, created to help young people and adults explore complex justice issues such as homelessness, hunger, poverty, racism, and educational inequity. These challenges require thoughtful

conversation and compassionate action. During their week in Winston-Salem this past summer, they engaged in relationship-building, education, storytelling, and service alongside individuals who are currently or formerly unhoused. Through these experiences, they gained a deeper understanding of the systems that perpetuate injustice and inequity, how the church is called to respond, and how we can all continue advocating for justice in our own communities.


