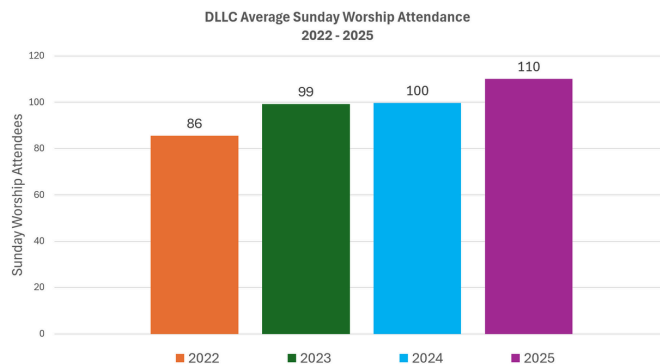

All are welcome to come, pray, reflect, or simply be together in a shared spirit of solidarity.
