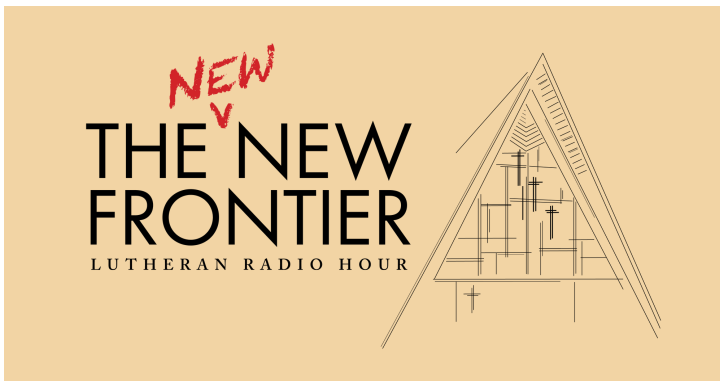
Interested in learning more about what it means to be a member of Diamond Lake Lutheran? Come to this information session to get your questions answered.

# WANTED: NEW A/V TEAM MEMBERS

We need more hands to help get our worship services online each week. Please review the tasks below and reach out to **[garyjmilne@gmail.com](mailto:garyjmilne@gmail.com)** to let him know how you'd like to help. Being on the team doesn't mean doing it every week—just as your schedule allows!

## **Preparation: 2-3 hrs during the week**

- Take home the A/V bag with iPhones, USB batteries, cables, and iPad.
- Charge up all the devices ahead of time: iPhones, USB batteries, and iPad.
- Edit the prior week's slides in Switcher (video app) to reflect the coming Sunday's program (based on the bulletin).

## **Sunday: 2.5 hrs (approx 8:15-10:45 am)**

- Install the iPhones & USB batteries in their designated spots around the sanctuary and connect to the iPad.
- Select the camera angles and views based on the activity during the service.
- Select the overlays to display on the screen at the appropriate moment. These will say things like "Sermon on the Steps" or "Communion" for those watching remotely.
- Pack away the iPhones, batteries, iPad etc and leave in the A/V room for the next volunteer.

Familiarity with iPhone or iPad a plus. Training will be given and documentation will be provided.
