

## **# GOSPEL: LUKE 12:22-31**

The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the 12th chapter.

ACT hosted the first official Disability Pride Festival in Minnesota in 2023, and celebrated this year on July 17th at the State Capitol. ACT's important work depends on community support.

Financial contributions to ACT help fund training programs, leadership development, and accessible resources that enable people with disabilities to challenge barriers and advocate for systemic change.




## **‡ LORD'S PRAYER**
