Watercolor Classes

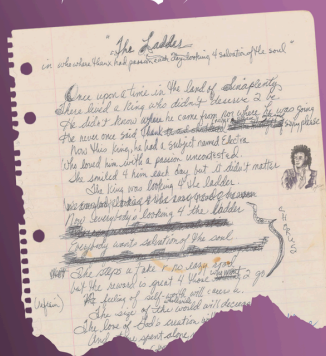
