

Grief Support Group Will Now Start Feb 26

Thursdays, Feb 26–April 2

6–7 pm

The first meeting of the Grief Support Group is postponed for one week, and the meetings will be extended by one additional week to accommodate the change. Led by Parish Nurse Parker Webster, each session includes a meditation, a Scripture story connected to stages of grief, optional time for sharing, and a blessing that affirms God's presence in the grieving process.

Participants are encouraged to attend each session, but drop-ins are welcome. This group is open to people experiencing—or anticipating—any kind of loss, including the death of a loved one, changes in health, the end of a relationship, job loss, or other life transitions.
